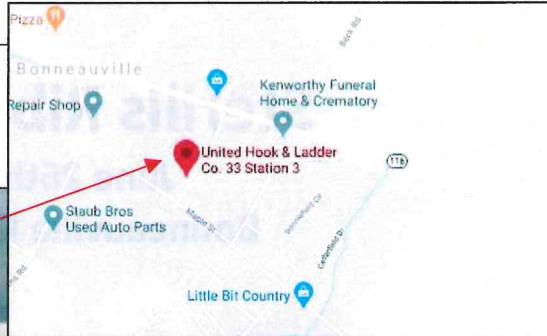


STERILIS NEEDLE DISPOSAL PROGRAM

A safe way to dispose of sharps

Step One: Place needles in a heavy plastic container (no larger than 10 quarts), such as a laundry detergent bottle or sharps container

Thanks to the support of many community organizations and various community donations and grant funding, the Sterilis Needle Disposal Program was able to be established in Adams County, and is the first of its kind in the County and Pennsylvania to offer safe disposal of needles to community residents.

It reduces the waste by 80% and reduces air pollution and carbon emissions by sterilizing and grinding used needles into harmless waste that can be thrown out in the regular trash.



Step Two: Open red sharps kiosk door and place container into the kiosk (located in front of Bonneauville Fire Department)

Simply bring your needles in a heavy plastic container (no larger than 10 quarts), such as a laundry detergent bottle or sharps container, anytime convenient to you, to the location shown and place the container in the red sharps kiosk located outside of the building. Staff will then transport the needles to the Sterilis Machine located inside the building to dispose of them.



Step Three: Drop container into kiosk and shut the kiosk door. You are now finished.
